*Interpretation of "Heavy Rain Warnings and Flood Warnings Accompanying the Approach of Typhoons"

(1) If a heavy rain warning or flood warning is issued after a typhoon has turned into a low pressure system, it does not fall under the category of "Heavy rain warning or flood warning due to approaching typhoon".
(2) If the "Heavy Rain Warning or Flood Warning Accompanying the Approach of a Typhoon" applies, even if "the intensity of the typhoon has weakened and it is no longer a typhoon" or "the typhoon is getting farther away", we will continue to take measures such as school closures until the warning is lifted.
