About the Japan Sports Promotion Center's Disaster Mutual Aid Benefit **System**

All members of Kumozu Elementary School are enrolled by submitting an enrollment consent form from each family. This is a system that provides medical expenses when a child visits a medical facility due to an injury or illness that occurs under the administration of the school. For injuries and illnesses under school management, this Japan Sports Promotion Center disaster benefit system takes priority. However, there is a condition that the medical expenses are 500 points (5,000 yen) or more (when the amount paid to the hospital using the insurance card is about 1,500 yen or more), then the medical expenses are 500 .In the event of being below this range and not meeting the requirements, the student will not qualify for the Tsu City Children's Medical Expenses Subsidy Program.

As mentioned in the April newsletter, starting this year, the amount of 460 yen corresponding to the Insurance will be charged in June, along with school fees.

XIn case of consulting a doctor because of an injury under school management, the school should be notified as soon as possible.
