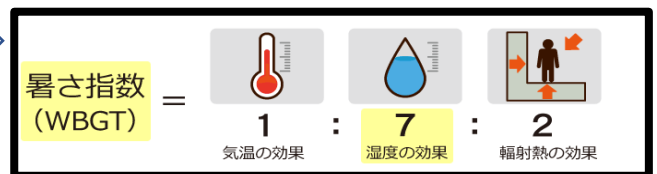


During the summer vacation, I participated in the training session

It has been a week since the start of the 2nd school term, but as of the 4th, there have been fatal traffic accidents involving elementary and junior high school students in the city. According to the City Board of Education, one car accident as of Wednesday, September 4th, there have been two accidents resulted in one death. Involving pedestrians, bicycles, and automobiles, with 2 people involved. There are was 1 reported case of injury due to a passenger in a car accident. In each lesson, children were reminded about road safety, such as checking the safety around them, wearing helmets, stopping and checking when going to and from school or when leaving.

Please save your precious life. To protect your child, we ask that you supervise and guide your children at home as well.

Due to amendments to the Road Traffic Act, from April 1st ,2023,wearing helmets will become a mandatory requirement for all cyclists ,regardless of age.
