

PTA officials and others have expressed the opinion that " Children get so engrossed in playing after school that



How to Behave After School and on Holidays

Kumozu Elementary School 2024

- After finishing the class, you must return home once.
- You must return home by the time specified below.

From April to October until 5:00 pm. From November to March until 4:30 pm

• When you leave, you must tell your parents or guardians where you are going, what time you will be back and who you will be with.

• You should not leave the school district only with other children.

Parents taking them to the place and leaving the child playing is also dangerous. The child must always have the company of their parents. (※AEON Tsu Minami shopping mall is outside the school area. You should not go there only with children)

• After finishing classes, when you come to pick up something you forgot in the classroom, you must ask the teacher for permission to enter the classroom. And when it's time to leave, talk to the teacher again.

• When coming to school by bicycle, you must park in the designated space.

(The place to park your bike is) •In the bike parking lot next to the main entrance or •Next to the P.E.warehouse in the field.

- You cannot ride a bicycle on the school field.
- You must not lend or borrow money or game software. Do not give or receive something, do not buy or buy and give something.
- To avoid any danger, you should consult your parents and not carry more money than necessary.
- If you spent money after school hours, you must tell the staff at home what you bought and how much you spent.
- You should not approach places where there is a [danger 危険] sign.
- Do not play in the streets or nearby areas as it is dangerous.
- You should wear a helmet when riding a bicycle and ride with due regard for safety.
- Be careful when crossing the street.
- · You cannot go to the sea or rivers only in the company of other children.
- You cannot eat sweets, snacks or drink soft drinks or juices inside the school area.
- If you have any of your trash when playing, you must take the trash home.
